DAYS 2 & 3 TADоба NATIONAL PARK

Morning & afternoon safari's to Tadoba National Park

Tadoba is the oldest National Park of Maharashtra. It is a compact National Park of about 120 sq.km. perched at an altitude of 200m and is placed 100 km south of Nagpur and 45 km north of the district headquarter and industrial town of Chandrapur



Tadoba National Park is like Heaven for Wild life enthusiasts which attracts tourist towards it. Tadoba is also known as the '*Jewel of Vidarbha*'. The area around Tadoba was once highly populated by the Gond tribes. Tadoba name was derived from their local deity 'Taru', who was killed in an epic fight with a tiger. He is still worshiped by the local villagers as the deity of 'Tadoba'.

Tadoba National Park is 623 sq.km. in area, consisting of two forest rectangles of the Tadoba and Andhari Range. Tadoba is also one of the India's 28 Project Tiger Reserve.

Tadoba has around 50 tigers along with some rare Indian wildlife such as, Leopards, Sloth Bears, Gaur, Wild Dogs, Hyenas, Civet and Jungle cats, and many species of Indian deer like Sambar, Cheetal, Nilgai, and Barking Deer. Tadoba also has a lake which sustains the Marsh Crocodile, which were once common all over Maharashtra. It is the main attractions of the park, which is the natural habitat of many water birds. The mesmerizing trails of Tadoba could be a treasured experience of a lifetime.

DAY 5 PENCH NATIONAL PARK

Morning & afternoon safari's to PENCH National Park

PENCH National park, nestling in the lower southern reaches of the Satpura hills is named after PENCH River, meandering through the park from north to south. It is located on the southern boundary of Madhya Pradesh, bordering Maharashtra, in the districts of Seoni and Chhindwara. PENCH National Park, comprising of 758 SQ Kms, out of which a core area of 299 sq km of Indira Priyadarshini PENCH National Park and the Mowgli PENCH Sanctuary and remaining 464 sq km of PENCH national park is the buffer area.



The area of the present tiger reserve has a glorious history. PENCH Tiger Reserve and its neighbourhood is the original setting of Rudyard Kipling's most famous work, The Jungle Book.

Satpura National Park is cradled in the Satpura Range (Mahadeo Hills) and straddles the State of Madhya Pradesh. With the adjoining Bori & Panchmarhi Sanctuaries, Satpura N.P. provides 1427 sq. kms of unique Central Indian Highland ecosystem cover to India's wild denizens. Satpura N.P.(set up in 1981 and 524 sq. km) is beautiful and unspoiled. It represents nature at its very best. The fascinating deep valleys, high mountains, rivulets, waterfalls and Tawa's vast reservoir combine to give this Park an unique beauty. The terrain is extremely rugged and consists of sandstone peaks, narrow gorges, ravines and dense forests. The altitude ranges from 300 Mts. to 1352 Mts. From the 4500 feet Dhoopgarh peak to the almost level plains of Churna the ride is only 60 kms
